



## Twirly Frog

Hand carved and batik painted the twirly frog represents the traditional frog, which features widely in the folklore of Thailand. A simple principle of vibration and resonance is used to reproduce the sound of this fascinating creature,

which grows to a much greater size than that of its European cousin. Hold the stick in your hand and twirl the frog clockwise to start the croaking. Alternatively hold the stick and twitch it from side to side for a gentler croak.
